Airport Manager's Report:

- Pouring of Cement for new taxiway—finished
- 90% of asphalt—finished
- Working on sealing the joints
- Monday—starting in to paint the lines
- Official Date: November 24th

- Contractor could release it earlier and City of Fulton could also accept it at that time
- Areas of concern: In front of Hangar 6 (Harold Blinn), there's still a large area of asphalt that needs repair
- Drain between Danuser's Hangar and Hangar 7 (Dohrn & Sherman) was raised more than 3". Now there's a big puddle that forms in the taxiway that goes to the back of Hangars 2, 4, and 6.
- Another low spot was created in front of Hangar 1 (Ewing) that holds water
- All-in-all the total project has turned out well
- Coming week...joints on tarmac are to have the edges beveled and resealed. Call Travis to make sure that you'll be able to taxi through that area if you have a flight planned.
- 2009: Plans to install a fuel card reader on the pumps. Will be able to fill up day or night.
